The "**Enterprise**" is a tall, two masted, triple sail 41-foot sailboat manufactured by the Morgan Yacht Company, "the Rolls Royce of Sailboats." The "**Enterprise**" is a center cockpit boat ideally designed for groups to enjoy hours on the open water. She is the **only** licensed and documented U.S.C.G. inspected sailing vessel in the City of Sarasota to legally carry more than six passengers. Our U.S.C.G. certificate of inspection allows for up to 12 passengers. We carry a life raft on board as well as life jackets for all our passengers' safety. **Enterprise Sailing Charters** is Sarasota's premiere professional sailing charter having been in business for over 30 years. The "**Enterprise**," a 41-foot Morgan Out Island 415, is unique in that she is the only 415 Morgan Out Island ever constructed at the Morgan Yacht Factory under Coast Guard specifications for more than six passengers, making her the safest sailboat in Sarasota and truly one of a kind.

Services:

Many families desire our exclusive charter service with a journey from our port at Marina Jacks with family and friends. This sea voyage provides a special opportunity for remembrance and perhaps a special memorial service ceremony. Our 41-foot sailboat "Enterprise" can comfortably accommodate groups of up to 12 passengers. On all voyages, the vessel will be captained by a U.S.C.G Licensed Master Captain and your needs will be met by a first mate.



Many families invite clergy to perform a small ceremony.



In some instances, family member do not wish or cannot attend the actual scattering of ashes service, but do wish that the desires of the deceased's be carried out. In these instances, Enterprise Chartered Inc. provides a supervised ocean scattering in the Gulf of Mexico.



The “Enterprise” will depart Marina Jacks and travel with Captain and Crew to a scattering site offshore at which time, with the vessel at rest, the Captain will supervise the scattering of the ashes while the Nautical Commitment is read, and the deceased's name is spoken as the final personal tribute to their life on earth. Any other provided mementos may also be dispensed; however, they must be biodegradable. Our Burial At Sea service ensures loved ones a final resting place at sea while relieving family members of financial burdens in their time of distress.

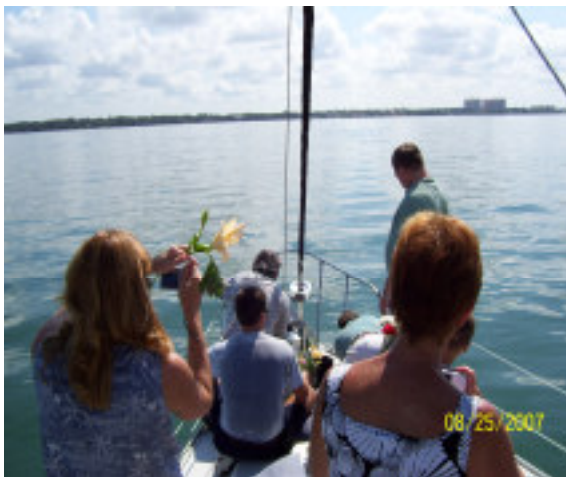

Captains Recommendations:

The best conditions for a quiet burial at sea are generally the morning hours when the Gulf is quiet. In the afternoon, the winds and the sea tend to pick up - great for sailing, but more difficult to perform ceremonies. Evenings, again, are quiet and are always beautiful with our gorgeous sunsets.

Our sole purpose is to transport you and your group out to the Gulf of Mexico and assist you with the scattering of your loved one’s ashes.

Services

Attended Services

Morning services - Up to 6 family members and friends may attend the service and travel with the ashes to the Gulf. \$270.00. Approximately 2 to 2 1/2 hours.

Morning services - Up to 12 family members and friends may attend the service and travel with the ashes to the Gulf. \$400.00. Approximately 2 to 2 1/2 hours.

Afternoon services - Up to 12 family members and friends may attend the service and travel with the ashes to the Gulf. \$450.00. Approximately 2 to 2 1/2 hours.

Sunset services - Up to 12 family members and friends may attend the service and travel with the ashes to the Gulf. \$575.00. Approximately 2 to 2 1/2 hours.

Extended cruises and special requests may be accommodated at a rate of \$150.00 per hour.

Unattended Services

Family and friends do not accompany the cremated remains aboard the vessel to the dispersal site. The Captain will conduct the scattering in a dignified and respectful manner, traveling to an offshore scattering site at which time, with the vessel at rest, the Captain will supervise the scattering of the ashes while the Nautical Commemoration is read, and the deceased's name is spoken as the final personal tribute to their life on earth. Any other provided mementos may also be dispersed; however, they must be biodegradable.

Sunset memorial services - Up to 12 family members and friends may attend the service to the Gulf. \$480.00. Approximately 2 hours.
